Extracurricular Activities at CAPA

In addition to our many sports activities, we offer the following opportunities for extracurricular activities:

<u>Mock Trial</u> – This club provides students an opportunity to work with lawyers, visit real trials and participate and practice getting actual courtroom experience.

<u>**TSA**</u> – The Technology Student Association enhances personal development, leadership, and career opportunities in STEAM, whereby members apply and integrate these concepts through intracurricular activities, competitions, and related programs.

Photography Club - Study the technical and artistic aspects of photography as an art form.

Yearbook – For seniors only – Plan out, design and layout the yearbook for your class.
